# Transporting

<b>Packing stones ready for transportation</b>	<b>We transport our stone by one of three methods</b>
<p>Packing stones correctly before transportation is vital to their quality on arrival at a site.</p> <p>At Thorverton Stone, we take great care to ensure our stones are wrapped in non-staining, shock absorbing packaging. The stones are then bound tightly to the pallet using cellophane. This prevents any chipping or breakages.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>1.</b> For orders of several pallets, we use a haulier, who has been working with us for several years. We are able to offer a self-unloading service using a “piggy back” forklift truck. The driver is happy to manoeuvre the pallets into a usable position with this option. Although we cannot guarantee a specific delivery time, we do try to accommodate you as far as is possible.</li> <li><b>2.</b> A specialist pallet carrier is used for smaller orders. They are able to unload their vehicles with a pallet truck, but will not be able to move the pallets any distance. No guarantee can be given to the time of delivery.</li> <li><b>3.</b> Very local orders of less than a ton in weight, and under 2m in size are delivered by us.</li> </ol> <p>Alternatively, you are welcome to come to our yard and collect if you prefer.</p> <p>Prices for delivery are given as part of the initial quote.</p>
