

## **Pointing Mix Instructions:**

Lay the stones with an ordinary mortar and leave the joints raked out to a depth of approx 10 –  $15 \mathrm{mm}$ 

## For the pointing mix:

\*

- Mix pointing material supplied with white or grey cement\* (see chart below) at 5:1 ratio (5 parts pointing material to 1 part cement)
- Mix approximately 1 part waterproof PVA to 5 parts water and use this to wet the pointing material
- Wet the mixture so it only just holds together when compressed in your hand. Do not add too much water as this will result in the mixture looking a lighter colour than the stone.
  <u>a normal bricklaying mortar is far too wet</u>
- When pointing, use a small tool (small enough to fit into the joint) and pack the mix into the joints <u>tightly</u>. Trowel smooth and leave to dry. Shade from strong sunlight and rain initially.

Pointing Mix Colour: (written on the bag)	Cement to use:
B1; CL3; CL5; P1	White cement (Snowcrete)
G1; Red 7; (BL - all);	Ordinary Portland (grey) cement
